



#### **AHCC Management Statement**

The construction industry is responsible for the socio-economic development of a country and thus this industry is driven by, focused on and centered in people. Construction practitioners world-wide are increasingly becoming aware that they cannot concentrate primarily on the technical aspects alone and ignore the workers and others who may be adversely affected by construction activities. In most developing countries, safety consideration in construction project delivery is not given a priority.

The current approach is that safety interventions occur in response to Specific, often major accidents or injury. The reactive management approach used for safety management is contrary to the proactive management approach used in other aspects such as quality, productivity and the like. Integration of safety and quality management using Total Quality Management has the potential of enhancing safety performance in the construction project delivery process. On the basis of an overview of the situation of occupational health and safety in the Jordanian Construction industry, this paper seeks to demonstrate the different modalities for integration of safety and quality, and their applicability to the construction project delivery process in developing countries.
